CORRIGENDUM
(KIND ATTENTION TO UG & PG ASPIRANT)

In pursuance of the Resolution No.4119 Dtd. 27.03.2018 of the Board of Management, OUAT Bhubaneswar, the seat of reservation for Person with Disabilities(PwD) have been enhanced from 03% to 05% for admission into UG and P.G. Courses from the Academic Year 2018-19 as per the letter No. Research-15/2018 4889/Ag.&FE dtd. 27.02.2018 of Department of Agriculture & Farmers' Empowerment. Govt. of Odisha and Notification No. 752 dt. 13.02.2018 of Skill Development & Technical Education Department, Govt. of Odisha & the seat breakup has been changed and incorporated in U.G. prospectus 2018-19.

In pursuance of the Resolution No.7337 Dtd. 11.04.2018 of the Academic Council, OUAT Bhubaneswar, it is decided that the following procedure will be followed for admission of foreign candidates into Under Graduate Courses for the Academic Session 2018-19 & will be incorporated in U.G. Prospectus 2018-19 as per clause mentioned below.

3.5.1 Fifteen percent (15%) of the seats of intake capacity in respective courses is available for **Foreign Candidates**, being sponsored by ICAR/ICCR or others fellowship holders sponsored by any statutory body of Government of India, New Delhi through the Indian Embassy in their country provided the candidates meet minimum eligibility criteria as per Clause-2.1 of UG Prospectus, possess valid documents with payment of normal fees at par with Indian student of general categories(not cost sharing)

Foreign candidates without any fellowship from ICAR/ICCR/any statutory body of GOI, can directly submit their applications to the University for admission provided the candidate meet the eligibility criteria as per clause 2.1 of UG Prospectus and possess valid documents with payment of fees as mentioned in Clause 14.2 of UG Prospectus.

4.3 The ICAR/VCI nominated candidates /**Foreign candidates** by ICAR/ICCR or any statutory body of Government of India New Delhi through the Indian Embassy in their country / State Government sponsored candidates/ J&K students under Prime Minister's Special scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) for admission against reserved seats are not required to appear at the Common Entrance Examination. They will be admitted as such against the Reserved Seats subject to fulfilling the eligibility as per Clause 2.

14.1 Fees for Foreign Candidates:

Foreign Candidates admitted through ICAR/ICCR /Any Statutory body of the GOI will pay usual fees as Indian Students of general category(not cost sharing) at par with fees mentioned with clause 13 of the Prospectus.

14.2 Institutional Economic Fees from Foreign National (Except those sponsored by ICCR under Cultural Exchange programme /ICAR and GOI Fellowship holders) : US \$ 4000 per year or US \$ 2400 per semester.

However:

- i) Candidates from SAARC nations are to be charged @ of US \$ 2000 per year or US \$ 200 per month in addition to usual charges.
- ii) Students sponsored by GOI under Nepal Aid Fund, will be charged @ US \$ 2000 p.a. and the expenses will be met by the sponsoring Ministry / Ministry of External Affairs. However, usual fee / Charges of the University will be paid by the candidate.
