

Admission procedure for Post-Graduate Course Programme (Master's & Doctoral Programme in Agriculture & Allied Subjects)

1. With reference to the Clause No. 8.1 of Prospectus for P.G. course Programme (Master's & Doctoral Programme in Agriculture & Allied subjects)-2020-21, it is for information of all concerned that –
  - 8.1.1. The Counselling and Admission to P.G course programme in Agril. & Allied subjects will be held between 04.01.2021 to 06.01.2021 by Admission Board of concerned colleges.
  - 8.1.2. The details of admission schedule has been notified on OUAT website ([www.ouat.nic.in](http://www.ouat.nic.in)) through the "OUAT MASTER & DOCTORAL COURSE ADMISSION NOTICE 2020-21" and was also published in newspaper "The Time of India" & "The Dharitri" on **24.12.2020**. The counselling schedule is also intimated in the intimation-cum-rank card for each candidate available on OUAT website [www.ouat.nic.in](http://www.ouat.nic.in) and also on website <http://ouat-lokaseba-odisha.in/>
  - 8.1.3. Candidates must report to the college for Counselling and Admission during specified reporting time. The candidates will be called rank-wise to be present before Admission Board. For Master's Programme, the candidate will be asked to choose the course / department from the available seats displayed in the Counselling Hall through final option form. Once, the option is exercised and admission confirmed by the Chairman, Admission Board, no request to change of course / department will be entertained.
  - 8.1.4. Once a candidate is admitted to a Department through any category of seats cannot switch over to another department through another category seats. The rest of the sub-clauses of clause – 8 (Admission Procedure) will remain unchanged.
2. It is for information of all concerned that the Clause No. 16 in the prospectus for P.G. course Programme – 2020-21 is modified as follows.
  - 16.1. A candidate once admitted to a course shall not be eligible to get refund of fees except the caution money.
  - 16.2. Caution money shall be refunded to the discontinued or pass out students after adjustment of dues if any.
  - 16.3. In case a student is promoted to next semester on scholastic probation but becomes unsuccessful in special examination and is detained, the entire fees deposited for admission into higher semester / year shall be refunded to the student upon his / her application.
