According to IMD, rainfall is expected on Monday & Wednesday. The maximum temperature is likely to remain at 34°C and the minimum temperature may vary between 17- 19°C. Mainly semi cloudy sky may be observed on Saturday, Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday and fully cloudy sky on Sunday. The maximum relative humidity may vary between 54-83% and minimum relative humidity varying between 17-26%. Light air is likely to blow in ESE direction on Wednesday, ENE direction on Thursday, Friday & Saturday and E direction on Sunday.

Nursery Management in Paddy

Don't apply pesticide if nursery bed is done in SRI method. Go for alternate wetting and drying method of irrigation.

Oilseeds

Due to increasing temp., go for sowing of oilseeds, which will result good germination.

To control powdery mildew in mustard, apply 1 kg sulphur per acre.

Apply irrigation in Sunflower in flowering stage for better yield.

Vegetables

To control bacterial or fungal wilt in brinjal & tomato, apply 1 g streptomycin with 20 g copper oxychloride.
